



Quick Start Guide

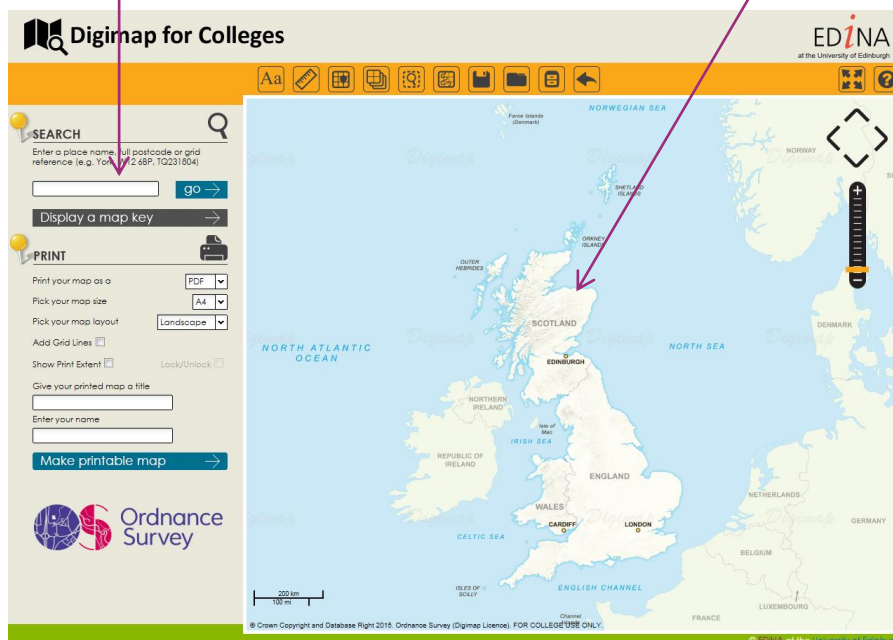
Digimap for Colleges provides easy access to a range of up to date Ordnance Survey digital mapping for Great Britain. You can access detailed maps showing building outlines, street level maps, road atlas style maps and maps for outdoor activities.

Use this geographical resource to view Ordnance Survey maps online. This resource is only available on Campus, via the LRC website or the e-resources page on Moodle.

On the opening page choose **start**








Choose your area by typing in the place name, post code or grid reference in the search box or double click on the map of the British Isles



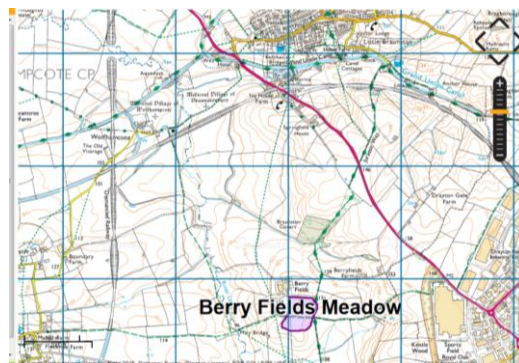
Choose the features to add to your map from the Selection Bar along the top.

You can:

Add  **annotations** such as  symbols,  draw an area, or  add a label.


 **Measure** the distance between 2 points or the area of a selected feature.

Add  Grid Lines and  Grid References to your map.



Maps can be saved to file. 

To print:
