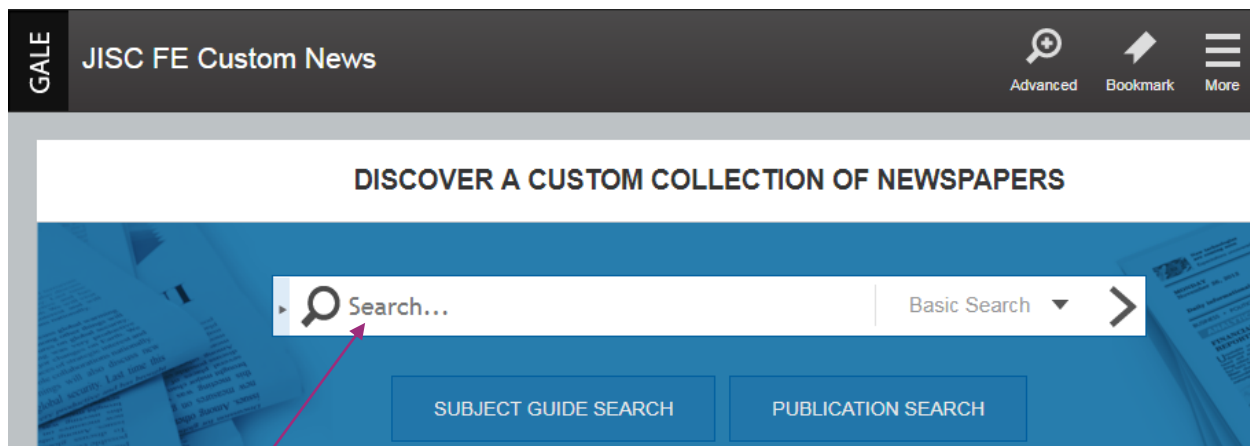

This full text newspaper database includes archives of many of the national newspapers from 1980 up to yesterday.

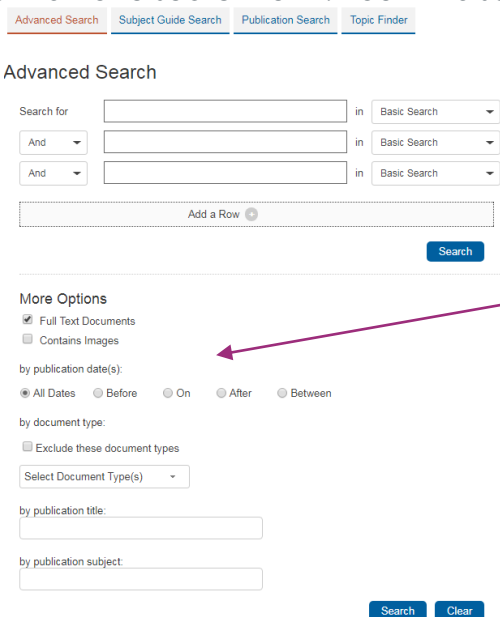
