

## Newspapers and Journals



The Library contains a large number of newspapers and journals (also known as periodicals or magazines) for both general reading and to help research for assignments.

**General titles** include daily papers:

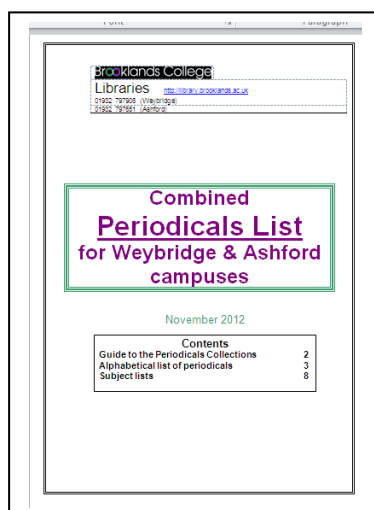
- the *Daily Mirror* (Ashford),
- *i daily* (Ashford and Weybridge),
- *The Guardian* (Weybridge),
- *The Times* (Ashford and Weybridge).
- *Surrey Advertiser* (Weybridge)
- *Four Four Two* (Weybridge),

You can find these on the newspaper stand near the Careers desk at Weybridge and on the bay end display shelves at Ashford

**New copies** of subject journals are displayed either on the bay end display shelves at Ashford or on a display stand in the Quiet Study area at Weybridge. New journals arrive either weekly, monthly or quarterly, so do look out for new editions when they arrive.

**Back copies** of journals are shelved alphabetically by title in the Quiet Study area at Weybridge. At Ashford, they are shelved with the books on that particular subject.

There is also a **Journals Booklet** which is available at the **Issue Desk** on **both campuses**.
